- All classes are non-competitive.
- Participation certificates will be given for all performances.

Vocal

Awards

- Awards will be presented to the winner of each class provided the mark is 80% or higher.
- Entrants must receive 80% or higher to qualify for a trophy.
- Scholarships may be awarded at the discretion of the adjudicator and committee members and will be awarded at the awards night at the conclusion of the festival week.

Regulations

- Rules in the Provincial Syllabus apply unless expanded or modified by a local rule. See the Winkler Festival of the Arts Addendum.
- Participants must number the first measure of each line of their music, in all copies, prior to the beginning of their class.
- Video and audio taping must be unobtrusive and silent. Adjudications must not be recorded under any circumstances.
- If a performer cannot attend at the scheduled time, request for changes must be submitted in writing to the appropriate committee 48 hours prior to the scheduled performance time.

Awards & Certificates

- All beginner classes are non-competitive. Each entrant to receive a merit certificate.
- Grades 1 and up to receive a certificate with a Gold, Silver, or Bronze seal based on mark achieved.
- If a “Gold” performance, single entrants of a class to receive a rosette ribbon and compete at Awards Night.
- The best “Gold” performance in a multiple entry class to receive a rosette ribbon and compete at Awards Night.
- Where the competitor in a given piano level wins more than one class, the competitor will only be allowed to enter one class at Awards Night. The title and composer of the piece needs to be forwarded to the Piano Festival Committee by 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, April 15, 2025.

Regulations

- Rules in the Provincial Syllabus apply unless expanded or modified by a local rule. See Winkler Festival of the Arts addendum.
- Participants must number the first measure of each line of their music, in all copies, prior to the beginning of their class.
- Entrants are reminded that they must provide original copies of selections for the adjudicator and themselves. Proof of purchase required for online purchases.

Winkler Festival of the Arts

Scholarship Guidelines (amount varies by grade)

- Recipient must have competed in a minimum of two classes (one being a recognized grade level list piece).
- Grades 1 and up are eligible for scholarships.
- Recipient must display a high standard of musicianship and outstanding performances (e.g. mannerism, poise, and attitude).
- Scholarships may be awarded at the discretion of the adjudicator and the committee members and will be awarded at the Awards Night at the conclusion of festival week.

Adjudicator's Choice Scholarship Guidelines (\$100 + Trophy)

- Recipient must have competed in a minimum of two classes (pieces must be of contrasting styles).
- Entrants of any level are eligible.
- Recipient must display a high standard of musicianship and outstanding performances (e.g. mannerism, poise, and attitude).
- The festival encourages the use of this scholarship towards private music lessons, tuition at music camps, purchase of music or any other area which would further artistic development.
- Scholarships will be awarded at the discretion of the adjudicator and the committee at Awards Night.

Dawn Bruch-Wiens holds a Bachelor of Music in Voice from McGill University and both a Post-Baccalaureate and Master of Music degree from the University of Manitoba, where she studied with Tracy Dahl. Praised as a "mesmerizing" singer with "effervescent vocal agility" (Opera Canada), Dawn has performed with Manitoba Opera, The Little Opera Company, Flipside Opera and Art Song Collective, Manitoba Underground Opera, Groundswell, the Winnipeg Symphony Orchestra, Lyric Opera Studio Weimar, and Opera on the Avalon.

With over 18 years of experience teaching private voice lessons, Dawn has also served as a sessional instructor at Canadian Mennonite University for five years. Passionate about the festival movement, she has contributed as a performer, teacher, adjudicator, and administrator for more than 30 years.

Theresa Thordarson's boundless creative drive stems from a lifetime of musical risk-taking. Whether writing original compositions, playing piano in traditional settings, or collaborating with artists across genres and disciplines, she thrives in musical explorations veering off the beaten path.

Growing up in rural Manitoba, Theresa experienced the classical canon as just one of many viable influences. Her curiosity has led her to investigate unexpected connections across disparate musical worlds. Her creations embrace playful poetry based on local history, harmonies lifted from Debussy's piano works, and faint disco beats sputtering from a rundown electronic organ.

Theresa performs traditional and contemporary repertoire as a soloist and collaborative pianist, with recent engagements including concerts for Send and Receive, Virtuosi Concerts, Nuit Blanche Winnipeg, Winterruption, and Lethbridge's Centric Festival. She also sings, plays synth, and writes adventurous pop music as one half of the duo Bicycle Face with guitarist Ava Glendinning and recently released a solo EP under the name Theresa Thor.

A passionate educator, Theresa instructs with a flexible, student-centred approach, encouraging students to think holistically about their connections to music and identity. Her experience overcoming a repetitive stress injury has given her a valuable pedagogical perspective informed by the Taubman piano approach. Theresa has studied and served as a sessional instructor at both Brandon University and the State University of New York, Fredonia, where she was also employed as a staff collaborative pianist.

Theresa makes her home in Winnipeg, Manitoba.
